**Market Observations:**

Prices of some fish commodity depends on the availability of stocks in the province (e.g. Tilapia-most cultured species in the cordillera, therefore wholesale/retail price is lower)

Prices of some fish commodity do not differ regardless of its species, e.g. Squid red & white, Fusilier flat or round)
